ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister for Revenue and Disaster Management, among others, has made the following announcement (Sl.No.16) on the floor of Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly during the Revenue demand on 17.07.2019 :-

“டிஜிட்டல் இந்தியா நில ஆவணங்களை நவீனமயமாக்கும் திட்டம் மற்றும் பல திட்டங்கள் நிலஅளவை மற்றும் நிலவரித்திட்டத் துறையில் செயல்படுத்தப்பட்டு வருகின்றன. நில ஆவணங்கள் தொடர்பான இ-சேவை பயன்பாட்டினை பொதுமக்களுக்கு விரிவுபடுத்தும் பொருட்டு, நிலஅளவை மற்றும் நிலவரித்திட்டத்துறைக்கென தனியாக இணையதள வசதியை உருவாக்கி இத்துறைச்சார்ந்த பல்வேறு திட்டங்கள், சுற்றறிக்கைகள் மற்றும் அரசாணைகள் போன்ற விவரங்கள் பெற வழிவகை செய்யப்படும்”.

2) In the reference second read above, the Director of Survey and Settlement has submitted the following proposal:-

- (i) Under Digital India Land Records Modernisation Programme (DILRMP), all types of land records have been computerized and Land records of 303 Taluks (289 Rural + 14 Urban), 12 Corporations, 92 Towns have been brought online using Web-based TamilNilam Rural / Urban software.
- (ii) Computers and accessories have been supplied to all the offices of Survey and Settlement directorate to enhance the usage of computers in day to day office routines. Internet connectivity has been provided to the State

/ Regional / District level offices of Survey Department. Also, internet connectivity has been provided to the survey sections of all taluk offices.

- (iii) In order to improve the communication between the Directorate and the District / Regional and the Taluk level offices and also to provide access to the staff of survey department as well as to the general public to various types of documents / records like G.Os, circulars, scheme related particulars, establishment related orders / communications like transfers, postings, panels, etc., it is proposed to create a separate website for Survey and Settlement Department.
- 3) The Director of Survey and Settlement has requested to issue orders for creating a separate website for Survey and Settlement Department to improve the communication between the Directorate and the District / Regional and the Taluk level offices and also to provide access to the staff of Survey and Settlement Department as well as to the general public to various types of documents / records like G.Os, circulars, scheme related particulars, establishment related orders / communications like transfers, postings, panels, etc.,

4) The Director of Survey and Settlement has further stated that based on an earlier discussion with NIC, it was decided to use one of the 3 servers which were procured for hosting Digitized Field Measurements Sketches(Collabland Sketches). Hence, it was proposed that the creation of Website for this department will be free of cost with the already available hardware resources. However, later NIC suggested that cloud setup may be hired (from ELCOT) for this purpose. Subsequently, in the meeting held on 30.09.2019, NIC's officials informed that since the Cloud setup hosted by ELCOT does not have facility for scaling up configuration in future, Physical Server may be procured. Accordingly, NIC has sent the specifications for 2 new servers for this purpose. As per Proforma Invoice received from ELCOT the cost of hardware works out to Rs.13,61,154/-. Further, they have requested to sanction Rs.9.00 lakh towards manpower hiring for this purpose. Therefore, the total cost involved towards the creation of Website (which includes procurement of 2 server and hiring of Manpower) works to Rs. 22,61,154/- and this amount is proposed to be met from the balance funds of the erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Computerization of Land Records Programme' (available with ELCOT).

5) The Government, after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Survey and Settlement. Accordingly, the Government order for creating a separate website for Survey and Settlement Department to improve the communication between the Directorate and the District / Regional and the Taluk level offices and also to provide access to the staff of Survey and Settlement Department as well as to the general public to various types of documents / records like G.Os, circulars, scheme related particulars, establishment related orders / communications like transfers, postings, panels, etc.

6) The Director of Survey and Settlement is requested to meet out the expenditure from the balance funds of the erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Scheme 'Computerization of Land Records Programme' available with ELCOT.

7) This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.64274/Fin(Rev)/dated 06.01.2020.
