ORDER

The Government have in their orders read above, approved a scheme of Updating the Land Records in the State by introducing a simplified system of supplemental survey to reflect the actual state of things on ground. The scheme is being implemented in 30 separate Units in the State from 1.6.1979 with 20 special units. Under this scheme, the holdings of the ryots will be supplementally surveyed, joint holdings of the ryots will be split up wherever the parties do not object and survey records are prepared with reference to the state on ground. New pattas along with rough sketches and showing correct measurements are issued to the ryots, and new 'A' Registers, Chittas, F.M.B., and Village maps are prepared and handed over to the Revenue and other authorities.

2. As the Updating Registry Scheme is found to be very useful to the ryots, Government have decided to extend it to the rest of the State except in the recently re-surveyed areas and the areas covered under Intensive Sub-division Scheme, as a Crash Programme. The Director of survey and settlement in his letter read above has accordingly submitted necessary proposals for implementation of the Scheme within a period of two years at a cost of Rs.10 crores.

3. The Government have carefully examined the proposals of the Director of Survey and Settlement and sanction the extension of the scheme of Updating Registry to the rest of the State using 80 new Units in addition to the 28 units already functioning. The new Units will be formed by the Director of survey and settlement according to the need.

The usual sanction procedure and the formalities should be obtained followed for the purchase of the items mentioned above. The Director of Survey and Settlement is permitted to pay 75% of the cost of Metal Seats in advance along with his orders.

20. The Government direct that the categories mentioned below for the additional 80 units will be recruited on contract basis for a specific period. Their services will be terminated when no longer required. They will be paid consolidated pay as mentioned in the annexures to this order. This, however, will not apply to the staff already in position in the existing 28 units, since those units have been constituted out of the staff in the Survey Department.

1. Surveyor
2. Junior Assistant
3. Typist
4. Basic Servant
5. Field Assistant
6. Record Clerk
7. Watchman.

21. The staff sanctioned other than those on consolidated pay will be eligible for the Travelling Allowance, Daily Allowance and other allowances as admissible under the rules in force.

The staff on consolidated pay will be eligible for travelling allowance, Fixed travelling allowance and daily allowance only while on transfer or tour as the case may be. For purposes of Travelling allowance all those on a consolidated pay of below Rs. 450/- p.m. will be classified as Grade IV and those on consolidated pay of Rs. 450/- p.m. and above classified as Grade

12. The Government direct that the survey charges in connection with the scheme of Updating Registry shall be recovered from the ryots in accordance with the provisions of section 8 of the Survey and Boundaries Act 1923. The Director of Survey and Settlement is requested to examine whether the rates now in force are commensurate with the expenditure being incurred under this scheme and come up to Government with proposals as necessary in due course.

13. The expenditure sanctioned in this order should be debited to the relevant sub-heads under the Major Head of account "229A-Land Revenue-RC.Survey and Settlement Operations I Non-plan- AO.Updating Reg Registry" (P.F.Code No.229-A-ACAO 0109).
